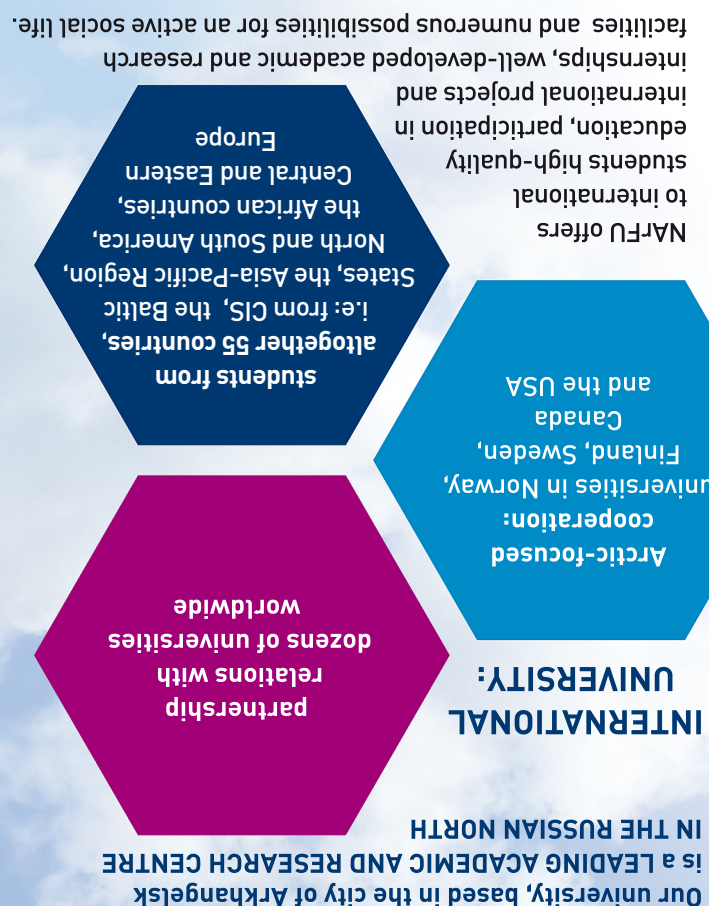
Arkhangelsk — administrative centre of Arkhangelsk Region — founded in 1564 on the banks of the Northern Dvina river 30 kilometres away from its exit into the White Sea.

Current population of the city — 350, 985.

Modern Arkhangelsk is not only one of the **largest sea port** in Northern Russian, it is a well-developed transport hub, connected with other regions of the country through the well-developed air, rail, and auto transportation systems.

Cultural and natural variety of the Arkhangelsk Oblast makes it attractive for inbound tourism. A unique museum of wooden architecture "Malye Korely", the Kenozero National Park, the Solovetsky Archipelago — are just a few examples of the region's numerous attractions.

Arkhangelsk is a **scientific and industrial** centre of the North-Western Russia. The development of forestry, wood-processing, chemical, petroleum, energy and mechanical engineering are the main regional industries.



The campus of the Northern (Arctic) Federal University hosts the following facilities:

- 28 academic buildings
- 12 dormitories
- Student canteens
- University Library
- Ski stadium
- 6 sport centres (basketballs, footballs, volleyball, athletics, table tennis, fitness)
- Swimming-pool

All international students enrolled at NArFU are accommodated in the university dormitory. The prices vary from 560 RUB to 3,000 RUB per month depending on room type. All dormitories feature a common room, laundry facilities and have Internet access.

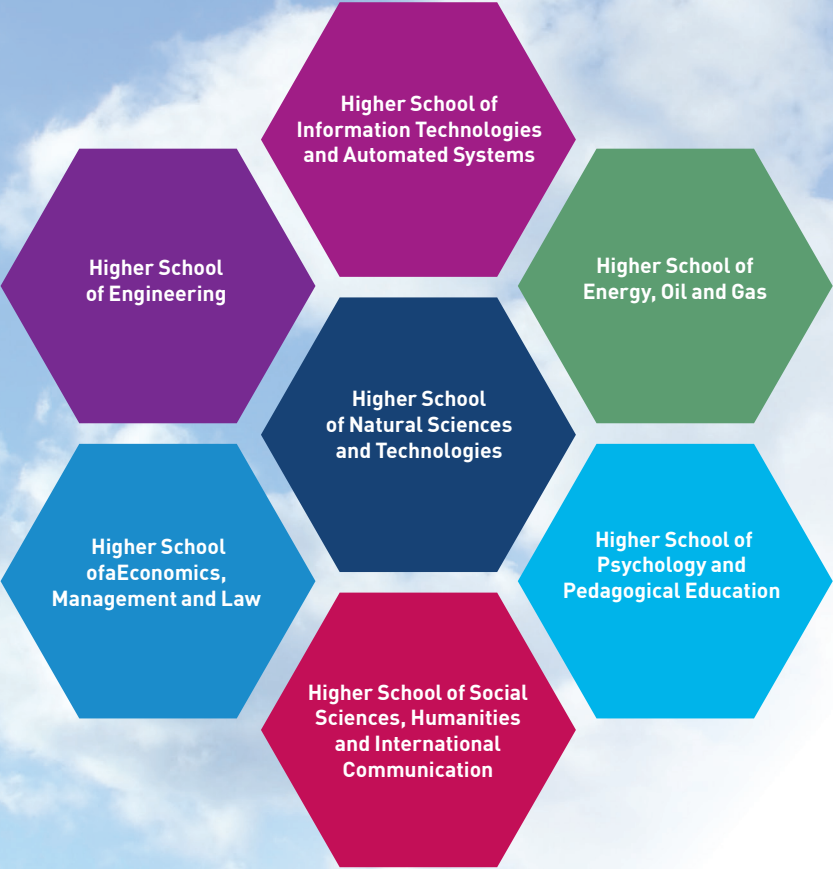

for international students

To prepare for entering the University the international applicants are offered to take **one-year course** at NArFU Preparatory Department with **intensive Russian language course** as well as **training in basic subjects** (Engineering, Economics, Natural Sciences and Humanities).

All courses at the Foundation Programme are taught 6 days per week in small groups (up to 10 students).

Studies starts from the 1st September, however there're possibilities for forming groups throughout a year
